You are invited to embark upon a 14day spiritual journey in which you will

- interact daily with portions of God's word, pray about how they can be applied to your life and hear from others who had embarked on the same journey before you.
- received insight regarding Christian giving: that it is for God's glory, and the act of giving becomes a blessing to us as givers.
- help you think more purposefully about the way you use your resources so that like the psalmist David you are able to recognize that, "Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand." - 1 Chronicles 29:14 (NIV)

practical advice for those with questions, doubts or fears about giving to the Lord's work

- **If you are NOT a Christian:** Don't worry about giving to God - accept what God wants to give to you -- complete forgiveness, a brand new start, the power to be good and to do good, help for your problems, the ability to forgive, and a home in heaven. If you recognize your need for these things in your life, bow your head and invite (by praying) and telling Jesus Christ that you are a sinner needing a Savior. Invite him into your life and ask Him to begin making you into the person He wants you to be.
- **For all Christians:** Always make it a priority to faithfully support the work of your own local church first in projects and outreach. After supporting your church, give special gifts and offerings to other Christian causes or the needy.
- **If you're fearful about giving 10% or more, try a 90-day test:** Because God says in Malachi 3:10 that people can "Test Him" in the matter of tithing (giving the first 10% of your income to God's work), We encourage people that are fearful about giving to try a 90-day test. Begin giving 10% of your income(s)
- **If you are married to a Christian but you both do not agree on how much you should give to the Lord's work:** See if your spouse will read through this material. Then talk together and pray about a mutually agreeable "testing period" and then begin to faithfully give to God's work.
- **If you are married and your spouse is not a Christian:** Identify any money you know you do have freedom with (read Luke 8:3) and set aside 10% or more of this money to give to the Lord's work AND/OR show this material to your spouse and see if you can try the 90-day testing period.

- **If you are a parent:** Help your children set up a place where they can set aside "God's portion" of any money they receive (i.e. - allowances, work projects, gifts of money, etc..). Have them give at church, to missions or to help people in need from the money they "set aside" for God.
- **If you are a student:** Do you receive an allowance? Do you work at part-time jobs? Take what income you have, and begin to give to the Lord from that. At every stage in life, you can always find reasons to postpone giving until later (entertainment, gadgets, car payments, house mortgage, kids' tuition, etc.). The best possible thing you can do is to start cultivating the practice early. Although it is hard to believe, God says that giving is the most financially secure move you can make because He will provide for your needs in the meanwhile (2 Corinthians 9:8, Matthew 5:38-48).
- **If you have "fallen behind" on your giving to God's work:** If you have knowingly or accidentally fallen behind on your giving to God's work, you will never regret the decision to "get right" in this area of your life. Review your financial records from this past year and pray about "making up" the amount you have fallen behind. The reality is that everything you have will someday need to be released to someone. Why not faithfully release a portion of what you have now to the "Someone" that's given you everything you have?

FINAL THOUGHT: As people are faithful and generous to the Lord's work at our church, we can continue to minister to those in our church, community and around the world. Your gifts DO make an eternal difference for our church, for others, and for you!

14 Day Journey to Financial Peace (14DFP)

HOW TO PROCEED

- Begin by setting your mind and heart in preparation to receive the implantation of God's Word. This preparation process includes praying about the time, place and people you will do the 14DFP with.
- Set aside, daily, a time during this period to seek God in prayer, fasting and reading His word. Invest time and effort to reap rich dividends in all areas of your life!
- This guide can be used individually and in groups, as in your families and/or cell groups.
- Instructions on fasting: the different kinds of fast and who can/should fast are contained in a handout ***How to Experience the Joy of Fasting***. The pamphlets are available upon request and at the Information rack in church.

Day 1 – God is the Owner of Everything (including all that you currently have or ever will have)

Water your soul

Haggai 2:8 “The silver is mine and the gold is mine,” declares the LORD Almighty.

Leviticus 25:23 (God says) “The land is mine and you are but aliens and my tenants.”

1 Chronicles 29:14-16 (David’s prayer after people gave generously to a building project) “But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand. We are aliens and strangers in your sight, as were all our forefathers. Our days on earth are like a shadow, without hope. O LORD our God, as for all this abundance that we have provided for building you a temple for your Holy Name, it comes from your hand, and all of it belongs to you.”

Psalms 24:1 The earth is the LORD’s, and everything in it, the world, and all who live

If God created and continues to create the immeasurable universes, then many of us could be forgiven in wondering why God does not supernaturally supply resources for His own work.

Obviously He can, but why isn’t He? The answer has to do with the heart, God’s and ours: for God knows that where we put our money is where our heart will be. And God loves us too much to leave us in the clutches of Satan and the world to have possession of our hearts.

1 Timothy 6:6-8
Godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it. But if we have food and clothing, we will be content with that.

Ecclesiastes 5:10
Whoever loves money never has enough money; whoever loves wealth is never satisfied with his income.

Proverbs 30:8-9 Give me neither poverty nor riches! Give me just enough to satisfy my needs! For if I grow rich, I may become content without God. And if I am too poor, I may steal and thus insult God’s holy name.

Philippians 4:11-13 - I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. I know what it is to be in need, & I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether

Day 4 – A Priceless Treasure Awaits You!

Matthew 13:44-46 "The Kingdom of heaven is like this. A man happens to find a treasure hidden in a field. He covers it up again, and is so happy that he goes and sells everything he has, and then goes back and buys that field. "Also, the Kingdom of heaven is like this. A man is looking for fine pearls, v46 and when he finds one that is unusually fine, he goes and sells everything he has, and buys that pearl.

Matthew 6:33 Instead, be concerned above everything else with the Kingdom of God and with what he requires of you, and he will provide you with all these other things.

Luke 13:28-30 How you will cry and gnash your teeth when you see Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets in the Kingdom of God, while you are thrown out! People will come from the east and the west, from the north and the south, and sit down at the feast in the Kingdom of God. Then those who are now last will be first, and those who are now first will be last."

Scriptures are from the *Good News Translation*

What is your most valuable possession? Why is it so valuable and important to you? How did you get it?

Have you heard about anyone finding a **hidden treasure**? Around the world, there are many stories about people finding a treasure hidden in the ground. Often the treasure is covered for many years before it is **discovered**. The person who finds the treasure can sell it for a lot of money. What would you do if you discovered a treasure **worth** a lot of money? In today's bible reading, Jesus talks about a person finding a treasure so valuable that he was willing to give up everything else just to have it. What might the treasure be?

! The Kingdom of heaven is worth more than anything we can own!

No treasure on Earth can compare to it. All of our possessions put together cannot compare to that of finding that Christ Jesus is what our soul need and long for..

Day 5 – Our Hearts Follow Our Money

Water your soul

Matthew 6:19-21 - Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Matthew 6:24 - No one can serve two masters. Either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and Money.

Mark 10:21 - Jesus looked at him and loved him. "One thing you lack," he said. "Go, sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."

The word that Jesus uses for money in this passage is an Aramaic word that brings about a personal and spiritual characteristic of money. The word What Jesus is saying is that money is a power that tries to control us. Behind money is a very real spiritual force that if not put under the authority of God, is capable of inspiring devotion in our lives. So Jesus is saying that it can be a threat to our relationship to God.

Day 6– Finding True Riches

Water your soul

Luke 12:13-21 Then Jesus told them this parable: "There was once a rich man who had land which bore good crops. He began to think to himself, "I don't have a place to keep all my crops. What can I do? This is what I will do," he told himself; "I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, where I will store the grain and all my other goods. Then I will say to myself, Lucky man! You have all the good things you need for many years. Take life easy, eat, drink, and enjoy yourself!" But God said to him, "You fool! This very night you will have to give up your life; then who will get all these things you have kept for yourself?" And Jesus concluded, "This is how it is with those who pile up riches for themselves but are not rich in God's sight."

Matthew 6: 19-21; 24 "You cannot be a slave of two masters; you will hate one and love the other; you will be loyal to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.

Scriptures are from the *Good News Translation*

Many people amass material **possessions**. They continue to accumulate material things with the view of protecting them for the future. Why would anyone try to accumulate for the future? Is this the really important thing in life? If not, what is the most important thing we need for the future?

Do not store up riches for yourselves here on earth, where moths and rust destroy, and robbers break in and steal. Instead, store up riches for yourselves in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and robbers cannot break in and steal.

! For your heart will always be where your riches are!

We must watch out and be careful that greed does not enter our lives. It could keep us from finding the true riches that last forever. We don't want to be like the rich fool that Jesus talked about in this story.

? How can you be sure not to repeat this man's foolish mistake?

Day 7 – The Road to Financial Peace

Water your soul

Romans 13:7-8 Give everyone what you owe him: If you owe taxes, pay taxes; if revenue, then revenue; if respect, then respect; if honor, then honor. Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for he who loves his fellowman has fulfilled the law.

Proverbs 22:7 The rich rule over the poor, and the borrower is servant to the lender.

Habakkuk 2:6-7 .Will not all of them taunt him with ridicule and scorn, saying, 'Woe to him who piles up stolen goods and makes himself wealthy by extortion! How long must this go on?' Will not your debtors suddenly arise? Will they not wake up and make you tremble? Then you will become their victim.

The Bible never said that it is a sin to borrow neither did the Bible encourage people to borrow. However, if one has to take a loan, it is wise that the loan taken is not beyond what the borrower can pay and to get out of debt as quickly as possible. Taking on debt and stress to buy something that can wait or totally not necessary is not the way towards debt-free lifestyle and financial peace.

Day 8 – Riches Without Sorrow

Water Your Soul

Matthew 6:33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness and all these things will be given to you as well.

Proverbs 10:22 The blessing of the Lord brings wealth and he adds no trouble to it.

Proverbs 28:19-20 He who works his land will have abundant food but the one who chases fantasies will have his fill of poverty. A faithful man will be richly blessed, but one eager to get rich will not go unpunished.

Luke 12:15 Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions."

Luke 12:20-21 "But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?' This is how it will be with anyone who store up things for himself but is not rich toward God."

The subject of money is so important to God that in the Bible there are twice as many verses referring to the topic of money than to faith and prayer combined. Jesus Himself taught more on money than on both heaven and hell. The Lord delights in blessing His children and He wants to release to them riches without sorrow as opposed to riches with sorrow that originate from greed.

Day 9 – Make Your Life a Blessing

Water Your Soul

Luke 16:10-12

Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much. So if you have not been trustworthy in handling worldly wealth, who will trust you with true riches? And if you have not been trustworthy with someone else's property, who will give you property of your own?

Genesis 1:28

God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in numbers; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and over every living creature that moves on the ground."

Psalms 8:6-7

You made him ruler over the works of your hands; you put everything under his feet: all flocks and herd, and the beast of the field.

Lloyd C. Douglas tells the story of Thomas Hearne, who, "in his journey to the mouth of the Coppermine River, wrote that a few days after they had started on their expedition, a party of Indians stole most of their supplies. His comment on the apparent misfortune was: 'The weight of our baggage being so much lightened, our next day's journey was more swift and pleasant.'"

How we respond to *losing* some of our resources in the course of our daily affairs depends upon whether we see ourselves as owners or stewards of the resources.

Day 10 – God is Our Ultimate Employer

Water your soul

Leviticus 25:23 (God says) “The land is mine and you are but aliens and my tenants.”

Proverbs 19:23 “The fear of the LORD leads to life: Then one rests content, untouched by trouble.”

Ephesians 6:5-8 Slaves, obey your earthly masters with respect and fear, and with sincerity of heart, just as you would obey Christ. Obey them not only to win their favor when their eye is on you, but like slaves of Christ, doing the will of God from your heart. Serve wholeheartedly, as if you were serving the Lord, not men, because you know that the Lord will reward everyone for whatever good he does, whether he is slave or free.

In the midst of the ongoing global financial meltdown, many fear the prospect of future unemployment. In fact some might already have been affected and are currently working at jobs not to their expectations.

One important area is to recognize that God is our ultimate employer and therefore our provider. When we work we do so for the Lord. He is the rewarder of all good things including our employment.

! Our God is Lord of all the earth!

Daily if we focus on the fact that our Lord Jesus is the Lord of all, we will then not be discouraged nor be in despair over our employment. We need not feel insecure if we look upon our employment as an opportunity to serve Him in our work place.

Day 11 – God is the Keeper of Our Wealth

Water your soul

Matthew 6:19-21 “Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. ²¹For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Psalms 17:14-15 You still the hunger of those you cherish; their sons have plenty, and they store up wealth for their children. And I—in righteousness I will see your face; when I awake, I will be satisfied with seeing your likeness.

Psalms 17:25-26 I was young and now I am old, yet I have never seen the righteous forsaken or their children begging bread. They are always generous and lend freely; their children will be blessed.

In 2008, many came to a realization that their wealth could easily be taken away from them. Overnight many lost all the wealth accumulated over the years as they found out that even the safest haven for wealth (the banks) is not safe.

Indeed even if we keep our money under the pillow, inflation will devour the value of our money. Just as the Bible aptly put it “moth and rust destroy, thieves break in to steal”

The only way to keep our wealth safe is to store it with God. God will not be a debtor of man. He will supply all our needs (and our children’s needs).

! The safest place to store our wealth is in God’s treasury!

When we give generously to God and those in need, we are investing in God’s kingdom and sharing God’s wealth. When we store our wealth with God, it will always be there when we need them.

? In what way can we learn to give generously to God’s work and those in needs?

Day 12 – The Path to Prosperity

Water your soul

2 Corinthians 9:6-8 - Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.

Proverbs 11:24-25: There is one who scatters yet increases all the more. There is one who withholds and it results only in want."

The world's mantra to increase your riches and guarantee your future prosperity is to hold on to everything, hoard it, accumulate it, save it, invest it. In addition there are others who even withhold wages, not paying bills on time or paying partially, squeezing every bit out of claims, etc.

God, however, has a very different plan: it does not disregard hard work, saving, or wise investment; it does reject accumulation and hoarding.

! I have watched over 100,000 families over my years of investment counseling. I always saw greater prosperity and happiness among those families who tithed than among those who didn't.

Day 13 – The Challenge of Generosity

Water your soul

Acts 20:35 - In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of hard work we must help the weak, remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.' "

2 Timothy 4:7-8 - I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day.

2 Cor 8:7 "Since you excel in so many ways—you have so much faith, such gifted speakers, such knowledge, such enthusiasm, and such love for us—now I want you to excel also in this gracious ministry of giving"

In Acts 20:35, Paul uses the word remember. This is the only earthly quote of Jesus not found in the four gospels. This indicates it was a well-known statement. It still is today, though we try to crowd it from our minds, it still arrests our attention.

! In their book, *The Day America Told the Truth*, authors James Patterson and Peter Kim reveal some shocking statistics on how far people in the US are willing to go for money:

- (25%) Would abandon their entire family
- (23%) Would become prostitutes for a week or more
- (16%) Would give up their American citizenship
- (16%) Would leave their spouses
- (10%) Would withhold testimony and let a murderer go free
- (7%) Would kill a stranger
- (3%) Would put their children up for adoption

Water your soul

Luke 6:38: "Give away your life; you'll find life given back ... given back with bonus and blessing. Giving, not getting, is the way ..." (The Message)

2 Cor 9:10-11 Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness. You will be made rich in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.

Isaiah 32:8 - But the noble man makes noble plans, and by noble deeds he stands.

2 Corinthians 9:8 – God is able to make all grace Abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every
